Environmental Policy Statement (October 2008)

Environmental Code of Conduct (October 2008)

- A. Foster a culture of open learning and appreciation for environmental sustainability with management, employees and hotel patrons.
- B. Maximize recycling, reuse and waste reduction in all areas of operation.
- C. Optimize the use of Preferred Suppliers who demonstrate green and sustainable business practices.
- D. Manage energy consumption through all areas of the business with defined target reduction goals for each activity centre.
- E. Maximize the use of local ingredients and food supply, with a specific target to purchase fresh local produce, seafood, poultry and meats within a 200km radius.
- F. Maximize the use of electronic data and the internet.
- G. Limit the use of non-recycled paper and harmful ink products.
- H. Limit the use of motor vehicles for company business, bulk order, and suggest non/low fuel alternatives for local guest transportation (walking, biking, etc.).
- I. Continue to ask for feedback from guests, employees and suppliers regarding new ways to improve our environmental practices.
